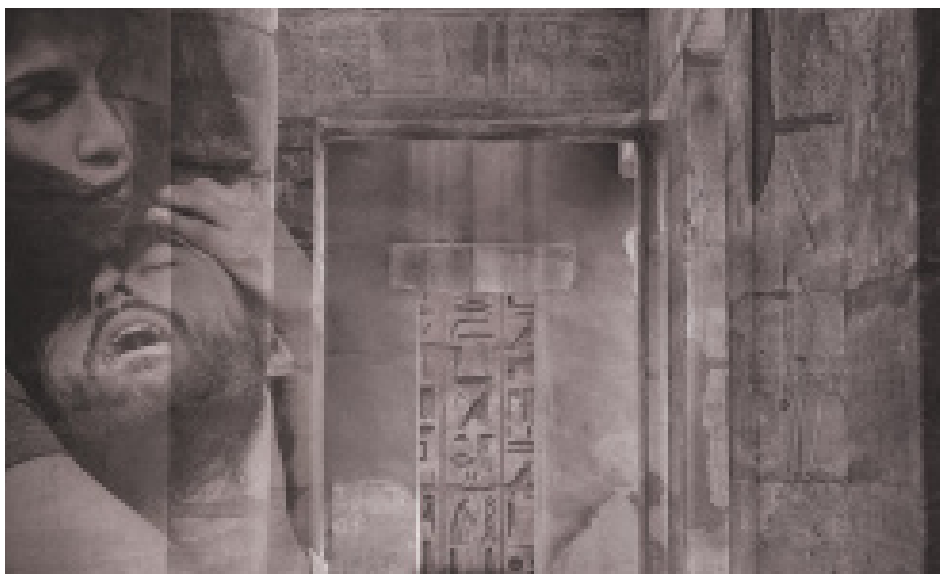


# Sinai Orchestral Theatre Ensemble - Yusuf's

Banished by his brothers, Yusuf arrives in Egypt as a slave. He earns the trust and affection of his master, Egypt's vizier, which soon after is jeopardized once his master's wife casts her eyes upon him. A story shared among the Abrahamic religions, „Yusuf's“ is a musical theatre piece about identity and power, faith and love, boundaries and transcendence.

The international ensemble of SINAI Orchestral Theatre in Berlin unfolds the story through a rich stage language inspired by Sufi interpretations and practices, combining songs, spoken English verse and intense physicality. The musical compositions merge oriental spiritual sounds of the Middle East with western polyphony.
